Albany Pine Bush Preserve Commission (APBPC) Education Program Fee Schedule and Guidelines

Beginning September 1, 2015, school (grades pre-K – 12), college, and special interest group (scouts, clubs, etc.) fees for both on-site and outreach (off-site) guided programs are as follows:

Guided (G)

- The fee for all guided programs is \$3.00 per participant; teachers and chaperones free.
- Minimum group size of eight participants (or minimum payment of \$24.00 with fewer participants) is required for guided programs.
- Payment is required the day of the program. If other payment arrangements are needed, please inform Education Staff at least 2 weeks in advance.

Self-guided (SG)

- Self-guided groups attend free of charge.
- Self-guided groups have the option of a 15 minute welcome and introduction by an APBPC staff member. To request an introduction, groups must provide a two week notice.
- Groups using the trails must be no larger than 25 people. Groups with more than 25 must either apply for a temporary revocable permit (TRP) through the APBPC Conservation Director or plan to divide the group into smaller groups for hiking.
- We cannot accommodate self-guided groups of more than 75 people at once.

Active Research Partners (ARP)

- Are you currently an Active Research Partner with the Albany Pine Bush Preserve Commission? Active Research Partners are college and university faculty who are engaged in research at the Albany Pine Bush Preserve and contribute findings, data or other relevant information to the APBPC.
- ARPs and their classes are eligible for one free guided tour of the Albany Pine Bush Preserve per semester. Tours may be led by Education staff, Science staff or another APBPC staff member.
